Positions Needed

Announcers: The voices of the station and the personalities with whom the public identifies. Responsibilities may include announcing news, hosting music programs, covering local events such as high school sports, Little Norway Festival and more. Basic computer skills, flexibility, and willingness to learn broadcast technology is required.

News Director: Local news and features are key to connecting with Southeast communities. This position includes collecting and producing news stories of local and regional interest in a timely fashion.

Engineers: Engineers are needed to assist the chief station engineers with maintenance of studio and broadcasting technology.
