Village Radio Ministry

NLN is starting a non-commercial FM station that will broadcast out of Glennallen in southcentral Alaska. Our vision is to reach rural Native Alaskan villages that have little or no consistent gospel presence. We will have Christian programming that is distinctly native-oriented in order to speak to the hearts of native people and their concerns, needs, and desires. This is a pioneering work among largely unreached Native Alaskan people groups.

All of these positions are SEND International of Alaska missionaries who will raise prayer and financial support for salary, living, and ministry expenses.

Positions Needed

Announcers: The voices of the station and the personalities with whom the public identifies. Responsibilities include announcing news stories, hosting programs, conducting interviews, and helping to produce native programming.

News Director: Responsible for gathering and producing news stories for broadcast. Will have regular contact with native people and organizations to find stories that are important to the native community.
